

Heads are to facilitate the staff members to modify the unit planning for the session 2021-22 in the light of the UGC D.O. No. 1-9/2020(CPP-II) dated 20.05.2021 to cover 40 percent of syllabus through online mode and 60 percent of the syllabus through offline classes.

Online mode means in these mode students will learn through the use of ICT tools. The suggested resources may be some websites, video lectures and e-books etc. Active participation of the students is must. Remaining 60 percent syllabus will be taught in offline mode keeping in view the guidelines of Government. Mode of examination will be decided according to the guidelines of Government and UGC. In nutshell total syllabus will be covered in blended mode.

The teacher should specify in the unit planning, the time frame, resources & evaluation methods for the topics to be covered in online mode.

Offline Mode-

Traditional class room teaching where classes are held in the face to face manner. Students & teachers are in physical proximity & can interact with each other. It may be chalk, PPT, Video, seminar & GD etc. Where teachers & students are actively involved in the process of learning.

So in the unit planning, the mode of teaching may be given for the topics to be covered in offline mode as the previous perspective.

D.O.No.1-9/2020 (CPP-II)

University Grants Commission in its 547th Meeting held on 29.05.2020 discussed the blended mode of teaching. It was decided that HEIs should be allowed to teach up to 40% of syllabus of each course (other than SWAYAM course) through online mode and the remaining 60% syllabus of the concerned courses could be taught in offline mode. Examinations for both 40% online and 60% offline teaching can be conducted offline. This provision may be created over and above up to 40% of online education permissible for SWAYAM courses. Examinations for SWAYAM Courses are essentially conducted in online mode. To prepare a concept note on Blended mode of teaching the UGC constituted an Expert Committee.

The draft concept note prepared by the Committee is attached herewith for comments/suggestion of stakeholders, if any, which may be sent to UGC on policyfeedbackugc@gmail.com on or before 06.06.2021.
