

Hostel Rules

1. Only those students whose names are on the rolls of the college will be admitted in the hostel.
2. Authorised visitors and relatives of the resident girl whose photographs (in duplicate) names and signatures have got registered in the visitors list by the patents at the time of admission are only allowed to see the hostlers that too on fixed days and timings.
3. The visitors are allowed only on Saturday from 3 P.M. to 5 P.M. and Sunday 10 A.M.to 5P.M.. No visitor (Male or Female) is allowed to go the boarder's room in the hostel.
4. The Hostlers will not be allowed for night stay with their local guardians.
5. it is the responsibility of the guardian to take his/her wards hone, for any long break. The college in neither responsible nor will keep hostlers after the last working day before break. Parent is requested to enquire about the last working day before break in last day of the examination of their wards.
6. Hostlers are allowed to go home only on Holidays' (not less than 3) and during break and that too only once a month.
7. After the holiday and break, overstays are not permitted, A fine of Rs. 50/- per day is imposed on those overstaying upto three days after which their names will struck off from the hostel.
8. It is entire responsibility of the guardians to make arrangements for the travelling of their wards Girls will be allowed to travel alone only if the parents give permission in writing at the time of admission.
9. If a student does not deposit the mess bill before 10th of every month a fine Rs. 50/- per day will be charged after that.
10. All correspondence to and from the resident students is censored.
11. Hostlers shall be responsible for the furniture and fitting of the room before leaving break for summer vacation the hostlers will get their rooms checked by the warden. Damage of any type of articles issued to them, will be recovered.
12. Hostlers are expected to keep their rooms neat and tidy and not to disfigure walls, doors and windows.
13. Use of room heater or press & heavy Electrical appliance strictly prohibited.
14. Hostlers shall take all their meals in the common dining hall in proper dress.
15. All Hostlers are required to deposit their spare money with hostel office or bank. They are not allowed to keep silver, diamond, gold ornaments. The college is not responsible for the loss of cash or gold.
16. Study hours shall be notified depending on the weather and need and during this time all residents are required to remain their rooms and study.
17. Attendance in the evening prayers is compulsory.
18. All boarders are required to attend the weekly prayers and other religious or cultural talk arranged by the authorities from time to time.
19. No boarder is allowed to miss her classes and stay back at hostel without the permission of the warden. The defaulters will be fined heavily.
20. No Hostler is allowed to keep mobile phone in the classroom and during college hours. In case found guilty disciplinary action will taken.
21. An urgency or illness must be brought to the notice of the warden immediately.
22. Strict disciplinary action will be taken if the warden is disobeyed.

23. The disciplinary committee (formed by the Principal) is authorised to expel the boarded immediately if they try to violate hostel rules.
24. Hostel seat is allotted for one academic year only. The reservation of hostel seats for the next session is done before leaving the hostel. The seat should be confirmed till 10th of Aug. If no payment is made till date the seat will be treated as cancelled.
25. Meals will not be served before or after the fixed hours. Residents must observe meal timings.
26. Residents must behave properly with the mess staff.
27. All Rooms, including almirahs and belonging are open to inspections by warden/Principal.
28. Any hosteller found guilty of creating indiscipline bringing bad publicity or indulging in negative politics is liable to be expelled with immediate effect.
29. Ragging is strictly banned and punishable by law. A student indulging in ragging can be expelled from the institution.
30. The Principal reserves the right to change any of the hostel rules and dues. The changes shall be binding on the residents.
