

B.A. B.Ed. (ITEP) Admission Process

Admission to the 4-year integrated B.A. B.Ed program (ITEP) requires qualifying the [National Common Entrance Test \(NCET\)](#) conducted by the NTA. Candidates must have passed 10+2 with at least 50% aggregate marks, followed by university/college-specific counseling and seat allotment.

Eligibility Criteria

- **Educational Qualification:** Successfully passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- **Minimum Marks:** Minimum of 50% aggregate marks (5% relaxation generally applicable for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
- **Entrance Test:** Mandatory to appear and qualify the NCET.

Admission Process

1. **Apply for NCET:** Register and apply for the entrance examination on the official NTA NCET Portal.
2. **Take the Test:** Appear for the NCET exam on the scheduled date, covering the required domains, language, and general tests.
3. **University/ College Registration:** Apply for counseling and select B.A. B.Ed as your preferred program on the website of your chosen participating university (e.g., Shri Sanatan Dharam Girls College, Bathinda(Punjab) <https://ssdgc.com/>).
4. **Counseling & Verification:** Participate in the merit-based counseling process and verify your documents.
5. **Fee Payment:** Pay the admission fee within the stipulated deadline to secure your seat.

Required Documents for Verification

- Class X Marksheet (for Date of Birth proof)
- Class XII Marksheet and Certificate
- NCET Scorecard/Admit Card
- Category Certificate (if applicable)
- Transfer/Migration Certificate and Character Certificate
- Government-issued ID Proof (Aadhaar, PAN, etc.)

Note: Dates for counseling will be announced as per the schedule given by NCTE.
